Batman: The Brave and the Bold is an American animated television series based in part on the DC Comics "team-up" series, The Brave and the Bold. Just like the comic series, it features two or more superheroes coming together to solve a crime or foil a super villain, but like the original comic series, which is different than the current series, the cartoon focuses on Batman working with the different heroes. Beginnings usually have a small introduction and are typically not related to the remainder of the episode. The show is split into two parts: a small adventure right before the theme song, and the main adventure right after that, similar to "The Batman."
