## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Why another arrangement of The Star-Spangled Banner? After all, there are many arrangements already printed for musical organizations that are fine renditions. The military bands perform excellent arrangements which inspire patriotism and national pride and there are other arrangements for all different kinds of music groups to provide the same kind of musical performance of this revered symbol of our country.

A short time ago, I was watching a television sports program that featured a nationally known singing personality The Star-Spangled Banner for the beginning of the event. The performance was very, very slow, and the singer wrong lyrics and used mordents and personal musical phrases intertwined in the melody to give it a personal ion. To me, it was done in very bad taste. I decided to write this arrangement to rid the feeling I just described.

nis concert band arrangement is written in the key of Ab (instead of the normal Bb) for a richer sound. The melody is prominent throughout, but begins without harmony by clarinets and alto saxophones. Harmonic structure is added gradually until the complete band reaches the climatic last eight measures with a full, dynamic, and respectful ending to provide a strong and personal feeling.

I hope you enjoy performing this arrangement as a tribute to our beloved nation.
