PROGRAM NOTES

Change is a given and necessary fact of life. We can't escape it. In most cases, it evolves slowly and develops over time, started on its way by a need, an influence, or a reaction.

Engines of Change presents this concept through the language of music. Beginning with one note, then two then three, a phrase comes together. Moving ever forward with conviction and determination, one phrase combines with another, weaving a living fabric of tune and harmony, until finally the change is complete, and the transformation has been achieved.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Designed specifically for first-year players, this dramatic work takes into account all the rhythmic and range elements that are presented in beginning method books. Students will have no problem staging a successful performance in their end-of-year spring concert.

Each note should be played with conviction, yet still with full value. The release should always be on the rest and not before.
