PROGRAM NOTES

This piece is based on material borrowed from two English folk songs popular in the Southern Appalachians during the early years of American history. The first, "Going to Boston," is an old melody made popular during the Revolutionary War era. Offering a tempo and rhythmic pattern that made it useful for singing while on the march, this folk song paid tribute to Boston's prestige as a trading port and as the cradle of the American Revolution. The second folk song, "Soldier, Won't You Marry Me?," is a somewhat wry commentary on the fact that colonial militiamen were responsible for their own outfitting with clothes, guns, boots, etc., as the government in those days assumed no such responsibility for these items. The tune is certainly of English origin, but its popularity in the United States and the numerous ways and forms in which it has been sung could arguably entitle it for consideration as a traditional American folk song.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

After a very peaceful and tranquil opening, measures 14–21 should be extremely bold and powerful. Subsequently, in sharp contrast, measures 22–35 should have a dreamlike, mesmerizing quality. Measures 36–39 should be forcefully accented and performed at a full forte level before the dreamlike atmosphere returns in measure 40.

At measure 48, where the meter switches to $\frac{3}{4}$, the ensemble must strive to play softly and hold the tempo without slowing down from the previous section. And, beginning at measure 72, the conductor and ensemble must strive to execute a steady and continuous ritard, finally arriving at a tempo of $\frac{1}{4} = 76$ at measure 80.

At measure 85, all players should strive for a flowing, singing style. Work to play full, richly-supported phrases, and carefully observe the crescendo into measure 93, as well as the crescendo into the highly climactic moment in measures 98 and 99.

Finally, measures 103–113 should have an extremely emphatic, driving, and powerful quality, while measures 114–129 should be bold, sustained, and well supported as the ensemble drives forward to the powerful concluding measures.
