NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Warp Speed is written for students near the end of their first year in band, utilizing the first several notes presented in most first-year band methods. The piece should be performed as fast as it can be played accurately and comfortably. Rhythm and pitch accuracy and ensemble precision are most important.

There are percussion parts written for seven players. If there are fewer players, you may eliminate the mallet and suspended cymbals parts. If you have more than seven percussionists, you may add them all on the Percussion 3 (tom-tom) part, playing on any kind of drum.
