## About the Composition

*Military Escort* is one of the most popular marches written by Harold Bennett (aka Henry Fillmore). Even when it was first written, it was so popular that John Philip Sousa was quoted as wishing he had penned this delightful little march. High praise from the march king himself! It has been my endeavor over the past fourteen years to breathe new life into the Bennett marches. Fillmore was a master of the march form and his tunes are just so good. I have avoided this famous gem until now, because there were other editions of this piece readily available at the time that I started this venture fourteen years ago. That is not the case anymore and so I felt it was time to bring the piece back to the attention of band directors and bandsmen everywhere.

These little marches are great for teaching younger students the march style and form. It does have the standard modulation to the subdominant at the Trio. All that I have done with this march is to edit the instrumentation to better fit the needs of today's young bands. The march is in its original keys. I have provided some suggestions for orchestration changes at the trio with indications of optional brass tacet, but get creative and change the orchestration to fit your musical tastes. Fillmore liked his marches fast and fun. I hope you will play it that way!

It has been my pleasure to have the opportunity to write this piece. I hope you and your students enjoy it and find it useful for your program.

## About the Arranger

Music by Larry Clark (b. 1963) is some of the most popular and most performed by concert bands and string orchestras of all ability levels. He holds a Bachelors Degree in Music Education from Florida State University and Masters Degrees in Conducting and Composition from James Madison University in Virginia.
