## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

*Talk is Cheep* is my latest attempt to funk-ify the common chicken! A little more aggressive than my chart from last year, *No Spring Chicken*, this tune will definitely get you in one funky mood! I highly recommend listening to the Belwin Jazz demo of this tune to get a great idea of what it should sound like—[alfred.com/downloads](http://alfred.com/downloads).

The opening eight measures should be played virtually legit, like a brass chorale. It should feel rebate, but is completely in time. For maximum contrast, the rhythm section should then really hit it at measure 9.

Beginning at measure 13, make certain the baritone saxophone is really “honkin’” the second time through as it bounces in and out between brass hits. Listen to any number of Tower of Power recordings and you’ll get the idea.

Measure 40, there is an a capella horn break-down with drum hits. Staccatos should be short, fall offs should be quick and accents should pop. Be sure to connect notes when appropriate too. Again, bari should be honkin’! Drum hits are big. If needed, the drummer could keep quarter-note time on hi-hat during the section during rehearsal and even at a concert if needed.

At measure 48, tenor sax 1 and trumpet 2 have solo chord changes, but guitar and piano could solo as well. The chart is written with each solo taking one chorus (backgrounds behind the trumpet). The tune could be easily opened up with each soloist playing two times, backgrounds the second time for each if desired.

Measure 64 is a full band shout chorus. Be sure to balance and blend the ensemble and avoid playing too heavy as it will bog down the time. The various section lines interjected between full ensemble should be heard, so make sure those horn players dig in. Examples are trombones in measures 66–67 and saxes in 70, 71, 74, 75 and 77. Measure 80 is  $\frac{4}{4}$ , but should still build so save some juice. It will do this naturally as more voices enter and the trumpet range move up.

Then the recap at measure 88 is the melody again and should drive like the second time at 13. Measure 108 is a shortened version of section 40. Last note should be played “phat” or not too short. I hope you dig the chart!
