PROGRAM NOTES

The opera *Lakmé* is set in India, under British rule, in the nineteenth century. Lakmé is the beautiful daughter of Nilakantha, a Brahmin priest who is guardian of a sacred temple. Mallika is Lakmé's servant and companion. A thick bamboo forest surrounds a flowering garden near the temple. In early morning, Lakmé and Mallika sing this pastoral duet as they begin their morning tasks.

PROGRAM NOTES

You may feature a variety of instrumental soloists with this work. Solo parts have been provided in C, B, and E. Percussion parts are intended to be subtle nuances, so careful attention should be given to dynamic markings.
