About the Composition

I wrote *The Heart of a Mustang* for the Montford Middle School Sixth Grade Band, Tallahassee FL, Holly Dunaway, Director. The band premiered the piece in Tallahassee on May 12, 2016. The Mustang is the Montford MS mascot.

A musical heartbeat pulses through the piece from start to finish, as well as (in the percussion) the galloping footfalls of a free-roaming horse like the mustang. This gives the music an intense urgency: perhaps a determination to push through life's struggles, or to escape the confinement of others' expectations and live life on one's own terms.

Take care throughout the piece to differentiate between the two "heartbeat" rhythms—the paired 8th notes on "1-&" and "3-&" (as at the beginning) vs. the dotted-quarter/8th rhythms (as at m. 7).

In mm. 41-44, the winds have four different lines going on at the same time. It might be helpful to break the winds down into four groups (perhaps with the rhythmically corresponding percussion) and get each group to master those bars separately, and then put them in different combinations of two or three groups to hear how the various lines intersect.

Flutes and Oboes (with Mallet Percussion and Tambourine)
 Alto Saxophone, Tenor Saxophone and Trumpets
 Clarinets and Horns
 Bass Clarinet, Baritone Sax and Bass Clarinet (with Timpani and Bass Drum)

Note also that on counts 3 and 4 in m. 41, two groups have the same rising 3-note figure—but in the alto/tenor sax and trumpets, the third note is an 8th note, while in the low woodwinds and low brass, it's a quarter note. In each group, the figure is consistent within its own line, so it's important to make the distinction in note length as clear as possible. (A similar difference occurs in m. 44.)

The Heart of a Mustang is dedicated to my nephew William Chavez, a musician in the Montford Band.

I hope your band enjoys working on this piece—I'd love to hear your feedback!

About the Composer

Robert Thurston (b. 1959) served for 20 years on the arranging staff of The United States Air Force Band in Washington DC, and was the Band's chief arranger-composer from 2007 until his retirement in 2014. In that capacity he wrote for the Air Force Concert Band and Orchestra, the Singing Sergeants chorus, the Airmen of Note big band, the Air Force Strings, the Ceremonial Brass, and numerous chamber groups.

Thurston conducts the Prince William Community Band in Manassas, Virginia. He has composed and arranged music professionally since 1980 for military, professional, college, community, high-school and middle-school bands throughout the United States. Before his military service, Thurston taught instrumental music for five years in Orlando, Florida, and Columbus, Ohio. He earned bachelor's and master's degrees in music education from Florida State University, where he studied arranging and composition with Charles Carter. Thurston was inducted in 2014 to the FSU Bands Wall of Fame. He is a member of the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP).
