Instructions for the Conductor:

In some instruments we found some recited words "sotto voce": Gaill, Normanni and Lochlannaigh, which mean "North Men" by Irish ("Gaill" and "Lochlannaigh") and French ("Normanni") people when they were attacked (measure 84), a sing out (measures 14 and 142) and "Vikings!" (measure 272).

During the firsts measures and from the measure 58, blow through the instrument (wind effect), from left to right in order to give movement to the effect.

During the measure 62 we found "Mmm..." in a tuned way and in a low tessitura with mouth closed (D natural in C).

In Horn 1.a and Flugelhorn we found "Bull Horn". The bull horn has to be empty, clean and sterilized. We have to cut at the peak (about 5 cm). We have to drill from this part to the other (the hole has to be about 5 mm of diameter), polish and varnish. To make sound though it, the musician has to support his lips and blow making them vibrate.

In Bass Trombone and Euphonium we found Didgeridoo, which will be ad libitum because it will create a mysterious effect. To make sound though it, the musician has to support his lips and blow making them vibrate.

In Mallets 1 we found Suspended Cymbal with a violin bow, with the cymbal well fixed to the stand, the musician has to slide the arc (with resin) by the external part of the cymbal.

In Mallets 2 we found an Anvil with metal hummer an pedal (motor mode "on", optative), the musician has to strike against a metal "oil" drum. The Hammer should be the hand, the strike will be so hard and will end the cry of the iron.

In Percussion 1 we found Snare Drum and Snare Drum off, and Cymbal with chain. There are some differences. Percussion 1 has to put on a Snare Drum stand with some chains (making sound with them moving the hand down/without throwing them to the cymbal). Percussion 2 has to put a chain on a Cymbal and hit it with a snare stick (the chain vibrates).

Instruccions per al Director:

A diversos instruments hi trobarem uns recitals "sotto voce" amb les següents paraules: *Gaill*, *Normanni*, *Lochlannaih!* i volen dir "Homes del Nord" anomenats així pels Irlandesos ("Gaill" i "Lochlannaih"), i Francesos ("Normanni") quan eren atacats (a partir del compass 84), un crit desgarrador i molt fort (compassos 141 i 142) i un crit guerrer que diu "Vikings!" (compass 272).

Als primers compassos i a partir del compass 58, bufar a través de l'instrument, sense fer sonar cap nota, de manera que només bufant a través d'ell produeixem l'efecte d'aire que es busca, ajudat i seguint les numeracions de cada instrument anirà passant d'esquerra a dreta i a l'inversa, donant moviment a aquest efecte de vent.

Al compass 62 trobarem "Mmm..." de manera afinada i a la tessitura més greu que li vagi al músic produint aquest so amb la boca tancada amb la lletra *M*.

A la Trompa 1.a i Fliscorn trobarem "Banya de bou" (és opcional, aquest pot ser substituïda per algun altre tipus de banya d'algú animal que pugui treure so a través d'aquesta). Per a la seva construcció, la banya ha d'estar buida d'en l'interior, ben neta i esterilitzada. Farem un tall a l'extrem on hi ha la punta (sobre uns 5 cm aprox.), extraient aquesta. Seguidament, perforarem des d'aquest extrem en direcció a la part més oberta de la banya (el forat ha de tenir aproximadament uns 5 mm de diàmetre), la polirem i li donarem una capa d'esmalt en espay. És possible que quan es perfori foradet la banya, però després amb la mà, fent pressió al forat, també sortirà i per a la seva neteja anirà bé. Per a fer-lo sonar, cal recolzar els llavis i bufar fent-los vibrar (com un instrument de vent metàl·lic).

Trombó Baix i Bombardí al principi trobarem *Didgeridoo*, serà ad libitum, ja que és per a donar un ambient atmosfèric i misteriós al començament. Per a fer-lo sonar, cal recolzar els llavis i fent-los vibrar (com un instrument de vent metall).

Làmines 1, trobarem Plat suspès amb arc de violoncel. Amb el plat ben subjecte al peu lliscarem l'arc del violoncel (amb resina) a l'extrem exterior del plat, de la part més proxima a la mà verticalment cap amunt.

Làmines 2, trobarem una Enclusa que percutidrem amb un martell metàl·lic gran. Aquest martell haure de ser el mateix que el que usarem per a la percussió 1. La percussió es farà amb el peu de caja, sobre el plat amb varis cadenes i baixant la mà fins a la terra produirem el so que es busca (no tirarem les cadenes contra el plat). El segon és un plat suspès amb una cadena al damunt que quan colpejarem amb la baqueta aquesta vibrarà sobre el plat trobant el so adequat.

A la Percussió 1, trobarem Caixa amb bordó i sense bordó i Plat amb cadena. Hi ha diverses diferències: el primer es farà amb un plat girat, la part que normalment es posa sobre la terra i pout sobre un peu de caja, sobre el plat amb varis cadenes i baixant la mà fins a la terra produirem el so que es busca (no tirarem les cadenes contra el plat). El segon és un plat suspès amb una cadena al damunt que quan colpejarem amb la baqueta aquesta vibrarà sobre el plat trobant el so adequat.

Instrucciones para el Director:

En varios instrumentos encontraremos unos recitados "sotto voce" con las siguientes palabras: *Gaill*, *Normanni*, *Lochlannaih!* y queremos decir "Hombres del Norte" nombrados así por Irlandeses ("Gaill" i "Lochlannaih"), y Franceses ("Normanni") cuando eran atacados (a partir del compass 84), un grito desgarrador y muy fuerte (compassos 141 y 142) y un grito guerreiro que dice "Vikings!" (compass 272).

En los primeros compassos y a partir del compass 58, soplar a través del instrumento, sin hacer sonar ninguna nota, de forma que solo soplando a través de él produciremos el efecto de aire que se busca, ayudado y siguiendo las numeraciones de cada instrumento irá pasando de izquierda a derecha y a la inversa, dando movimiento a este efecto de viento.

En el compass 62 encontraremos "Mmm..." de manera afinada y a la tessitura más grave que le vaya al músico produciendo este sonido con la boca cerrada con la letra *M*.

En la Trompa 1.a y Fliscorno encontraremos "Cuerno de toro" (es opcional, éste puede ser substituido por otro tipo de cuerno de animal que pueda producir sonido). Para su construcción, el cuerno debe estar vacío del interior, bien limpio y esterilizado. Haremos un corte al extremo donde hay la punta (sobre unos 5 cm aproximadamente), extrayendo ésta. Seguidamente, perforaremos desde este extremo en dirección a la parte más abierta del cuerno (el agujero debe tener aproximadamente unos 5 mm de diámetro), lo puliremos y le daremos una capa de esmalte en espay. Es posible que cuando se separe, agujereemos el cuerno, pero después, con la mano y haciendo presión en el agujero, también sonará y para su limpieza irá bien. Para hacerlo sonar, se apoyan los labios y se sopla haciéndolos vibrar (como un instrumento de viento metal).

Trombón Bajo y Bombardino al principio encontraremos *Didgeridoo*, será ad libitum, ya que es para dar un ambiente atmosférico y misterioso al principio. Para hacerlo sonar, se apoyan los labios y se sopla haciéndolos vibrar (como un instrumento de viento metal).

Láminas 1, encontraremos Plato suspendido con arco de violonchelo. Con el plato bien sujetado al pie, deslizaremos el arco del violonchelo (con resina) al extremo exterior del plato, de la parte más próxima a la mano verticalmente hacia arriba.

Láminas 2, encontraremos un Yunque que percutiremos con un Martillo grande. A continuación, con el pedal del vibráfono pisado (si se dispone de motor, modo "on", ojalá), golpearemos el yunque con resina (al pedal del vibráfono pisado (si se dispone de motor, modo "on", ojalá), golpearemos el yunque con resina) al extremo inferior de la lámina de la nota indicada, de la parte más baja. En la percusión 1, en el compasso 143, encontraremos un golpe que se realizará con un Martillo grande. Este golpe se hará con el martillo contra un bidón metálico grande. Este martillo debería ser lo más grande que sea posible y su golpe culminaría el grito de los dos compassos anteriores.

En la Percusión 1, encontraremos Caja con bordón y sin bordón, y Plato con cadena. Hay varias diferencias: el primero se haría con un plato girado la parte que normalmente es la parte que se pone sobre la tierra y puesto sobre un pie de caja, sobre el plato con varias cadenas, bajando la mano desde cierta altura produciremos el sonido que se busca (no tiraremos las cadenas contra el plato). El segundo es un plato suspendido con una cadena que se coloca encima que cuando golpeamos con la baqueta, ésta vibrará sobre el plato produciendo el sonido deseado.
